1500 | $914 + 628$
$1542 = 1500$ |
| 3) A zoologist was checking the weights of two gorillas. Gorilla A weighed 591 pounds and gorilla B weighed 997 pounds. To the nearest ten, what is the combined weight of both gorillas? | $590 + 1000$
1590 | $591 + 997$
$1588 = 1590$ |
| 4) The classes in the fourth grade were counting the fundraiser money they earned. Mr. Smith's Class earned 988 dollars and Mrs. White's class earned 437 dollars. To the nearest ten, how much did they earn total? | $990 + 440$
1430 | $988 + 437$
$1425 = 1430$ |
| 5) A pet store had 508 goldfish and 580 clown fish. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of both types of fish? | $500 + 600$
1100 | $508 + 580$
$1088 = 1100$ |
| 6) In one month a furniture store sold 409 plastic chairs and 200 wooden chairs. To the nearest hundred, how many chairs did they sell total? | $400 + 200$
600 | $409 + 200$
$609 = 600$ |
| 7) On Monday a shipping company sent out 255 boxes. On Tuesday they sent out another 399 boxes. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of boxes they sent out? | $300 + 400$
700 | $255 + 399$
$654 = 700$ |
| 8) In a month, a video store rented out 267 action movies and 934 other types of movies. To the nearest hundred, what is the sum of the movies they rented in a month? | $300 + 900$
1200 | $267 + 934$
$1201 = 1200$ |
| 9) While working on his car, Mike spent 868 dollars on a new paint job and 157 dollars on the transmission. To the nearest ten, how much money did he spend total? | $870 + 160$
1030 | $868 + 157$
$1025 = 1030$ |
| 10) Over the summer John earned 160 dollars mowing lawns and another 562 dollars trimming weeds. To the nearest ten, how much money did John make total? | $160 + 560$
720 | $160 + 562$
$722 = 720$ |
