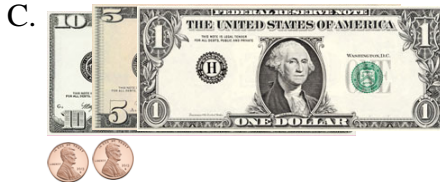




Solve each problem.

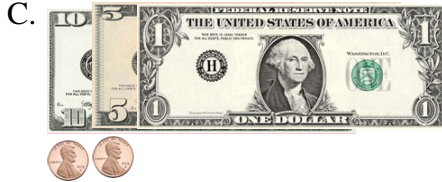
